

Like you, the Groundwork team has been adjusting to unfathomable change, at lightning speed, while also trying to take care of our own families in this new work-from-home paradigm. As the stress levels increased on a daily basis, along with an occasional assist by internet streaming services to entertain children in our care, we embraced the mantra of Anna from Disney's Frozen 2 to get us through each grueling challenge: "All one can do is the next right thing."

With each day bringing more mind-boggling and seemingly insurmountable obstacles that needed immediate attention, Groundwork's small but mighty team, not surprisingly, rose to this extraordinary moment in service to kids and families. Webinars, surveys, virtual meetings

and social media efforts were all on overdrive. Thousands of Ohioans have been engaged in our critical work in this short period of time unified by the common purpose to do the next right thing for children.
